The Structure: The 7 Trumpets (Judgments)

8:6-9:12	The first five trumpets
9:13-20	The 6th trumpet brings to the brink of the end
10:1-11:14	Interlude (as between the 6th and 7th seals)
11:15-19	The 7th trumpet (period of the end) (see prior lesson for more details)

The Interlude

This interlude seems to be concurrent with the trumpets. The interlude of the seals showed events before and after, not concurrent. This interlude switches scenes, or views other characters, much like switching scenes in a movie or when reading a book.
